It provides pointers to get conversation going and is not a full explanation of all health and safety requirements related to this subject and should not be relied on as such.

- Is silica dust produced in this workplace?
 For example, are concrete or concrete products drilled/ cut/ chased on this project.
- What tasks would produce silica dust? For example, are there cutting/ drilling operations of blocks & bricks / roofing or flooring tiles undertaken
- 3. Who could be affected by the silica dust produced by each of the tasks? Brickies/tilers/roofers/ cleaners etc
- How can you minimise the level of dust being produced? Dampening/ dust extraction
- If you are involved with operations which produces silica dust, have you been face fit tested? Yes/ no
- Have you seen or have had a silica dust risk assessment communicated to you? Yes/ No
- What health conditions can silica dust cause? Silicosis/ asthma/ lung cancer
- How could a worker's family be affected if they contracted a health condition associated with silica dust?
 Loved one becomes sick loss of earnings, mortgage/ loan arrears

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
