Do you need a new risk assessment for the jobs you will be doing this week?



Have you read and revised your previous risk assessment for the jobs you'll be starting back at this week?



Have you got sufficient plant and resources with you to do the work?



Are you aware of your local surroundings on site? Has anything changed in the meantime?



Are you aware of the emergency procedures to safely exit the site if necessary?



Are you aware of the ground conditions?



Is there enough light to allow you to work safely?



Have you got the correct PPE to allow you to work in the cold/dark/damp days at this time of year?



Are you aware of others who might be working in the same vicinity as you? Have you discussed their potential movements with them?



Have you tried, tested and inspected any tools, plant or machinery you will need in the next week? Are they working safely? Do they need repaired or serviced?
