## **Underground Services: Introduction**

- Underground services continue to be one of the biggest health and safety hazards in our industry.
- The most significant incidents have tragically resulted in fatalities and life changing injuries.
- Routinely the root cause of these incidents include poor quality or inaccurate information about buried utility locations, little or no consideration of diversion during design development, lack of consistency of safe working practices across the industry, inadequate or inconsistent control measures on site or human behaviours e.g. failing to follow RAMS.
